**WATER FACILITIES** Meter works owned and operated by Omaha Water Co. Main Water Works at Supply from Missouri River. Capacity 10 million gallons. 307 ft. low city datum. 3 pumping stations in operation. **FIRE DEPARTMENT** 100 paid men including chief and fire reporter. 13 companies. 50 horses. Gamewell fire alarm system - 53 boxes, also the engine telephone system. One extra size City & Jones, one Altrons and two tractor driven fire engines, two 100 gal. chemical engines, 10 portable fire extinguishers, 4 hose engines, 3 hose carriers. One hand truck hook & ladder truck. Steeple, large H.L. Truck. One Hale water tower. 17,000 ft. of hose (1000 ft. wrapped condition). This department covers the city of Omaha, also East Omaha and Dundie Place by special call.

**SOUTH OMAHA** has independent fire dept. **CHANCE** has a volunteer company of 10 men. One small hook & ladder truck, 700 ft. of hose on hand copy.

**STREET LIGHTS** has no special fire protection. Streets - 31 miles paved, 37% of total mileage of 300. 4 Miles of paved alleys. Grades refer to low water mark in Missouri River on 10/19/02 which is 962 ft. above sea level at New Orleans. Free of city 24% 32 miles. Public lights - electric, gas & gasoline.
